

## Exhibit B(1)

### Relief Requested: Managing Conservatorship

See Texas Family Code Chapter 153

It is in the best interest of the child(ren) that I, the Intervenor, be appointed sole managing conservator of the child(ren). Appointment of the parents as joint managing conservators or appointment of either parent as sole managing conservator would not be in the best interest of the child(ren).

Given the best interest considerations listed in Texas Family Code § 263.307, and the importance of prompt and permanent placement of the child(ren) in a safe environment, I request that the Court dismiss the Department of Family and Protective Services as temporary managing conservator of the child(ren), and appoint me as the child(ren)'s permanent managing conservator with all the rights and duties of a managing conservator as set out in Texas Family Code Chapter 153.

#### 1. Possessory Conservators
